MADD Service Request Information

The MADD Northern Virginia Affiliate is working to stop drunk driving and prevent underage drinking by offering various services to the community, including the Crashed Car Trailer Exhibit (CCTE), speakers' bureau, booth displays for events, and educational materials. We do our best to accommodate all submitted requests.

Speakers' Bureau

MADD has an active Speakers' Bureau that provides dynamic speakers to audiences throughout Northern Virginia. These speakers are trained to discuss the effects and impact of drinking and driving, and underage drinking, and to discuss MADD to groups of all sizes and ages. Our speakers are often family members of victims of drunk driving crashes or victims themselves who share their personal story as a way to help others understand the impact of drunk driving on a personal level.

Booth Displays and/or Materials

MADD can provide displays and/or information booths for your event, and educational materials for distribution. We have a professional table-top display, literature, artwork, and videos available. You may request to have a MADD volunteer on-hand or you may request to borrow materials. Please submit the Speaker and/or Materials Request form a minimum of four weeks (and no more than three months) before your event. Once your form has been received, we will contact you to discuss further details.

Crashed Car Trailer Exhibit (CCTE)

The MADD Northern Virginia CCTE is available for schools, law enforcement agencies, community groups, and other public venues in Northern Virginia. The CCTE is displayed on a flatbed trailer and features a vehicle that was driven by a young man who crashed and killed his passenger while driving under the influence of alcohol. Pictures from the scene of the crime excerpts from the police report are included in the display.

To request our CCTE, please complete and submit the attached form a minimum of four weeks before your event. Please do not submit your request more than three months before your event. Once your form has been received, we will contact you to discuss further details. The CCTE reservations are made first come, first serve, with priority given to requests in MADD Northern Virginia's coverage area, which include Arlington, Fairfax, Fauquier, Loudoun, Prince William counties as well as the cities of Alexandria, D.C., Fairfax, Falls Church, Manassas and Manassas Park.
