Attached are position statements for SB521 (Ignition Interlock for repeat offenders) and HB57/SB148 (Open Container). These will come in handy should the media contact you about these bills or if you or others want to contact your legislators to encourage adoption of both bills. HB57 is dead for all intents and purposes, but its Senate version still has a chance. SB521 passed through the Senate and after crossover day will be considered by the House.

These talking points attempt to answer most questions/challenges about both bills that were brought up on either Legislative Action Day or on the Floor.
